

## Back Valley Hut, Fiordland National Park

### Wild file

**Access:** Boat access is required from Manpouri across the Mararoa River outlet to and from the track

**Distance:** 6.44km

**Time:** 2-3hr

**Grade:** Easy

**Accommodation:** Back Valley Hut, **four bunks**

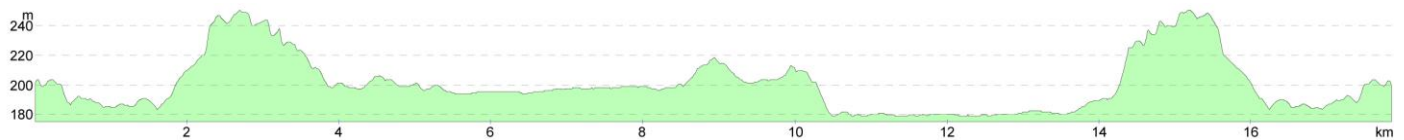
**Topo50 Map:** CE07

### Description

Routes are possible from here via 4WD tracks in Packers Creek (permission required from Black Peak Station) or from the west via an easement through Glenrock Creek to Turton's Saddle in Hakatere Conservation Park.

First up is an old musterer's hut, from which you can head up the hill towards the peak. In winter you'll need crampons and ice axes. Aim for the post-glacial basin directly east of the summit. From here it is relatively easy travel to the summit. Return via the north-east ridge but beware of bluffs on the eastern side.
