

## Hooker Glacier, Aoraki/Mt Cook National Park

### Wild file

**Access:** Signposted from the White Horse Hill camp ground, north of Mt Cook village

**Distance:** 5km

**Time:** 2hr

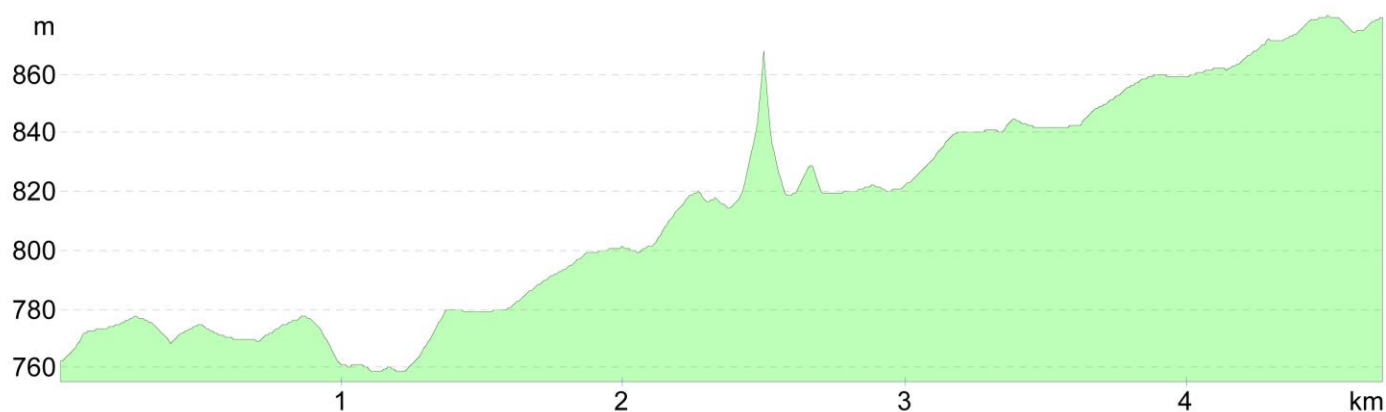
**Grade:** Easy

### Description

This is an all season trip, though mid-winter is a spectacular time to be among New Zealand's tallest mountains. The well-benched track crosses over several swing bridges and passes the Alpine Memorial before reaching Stocking Stream Shelter. From the shelter follow the Hooker River to its source at the terminal lake. This is one of the area's most popular day walks and offers stunning vistas.
